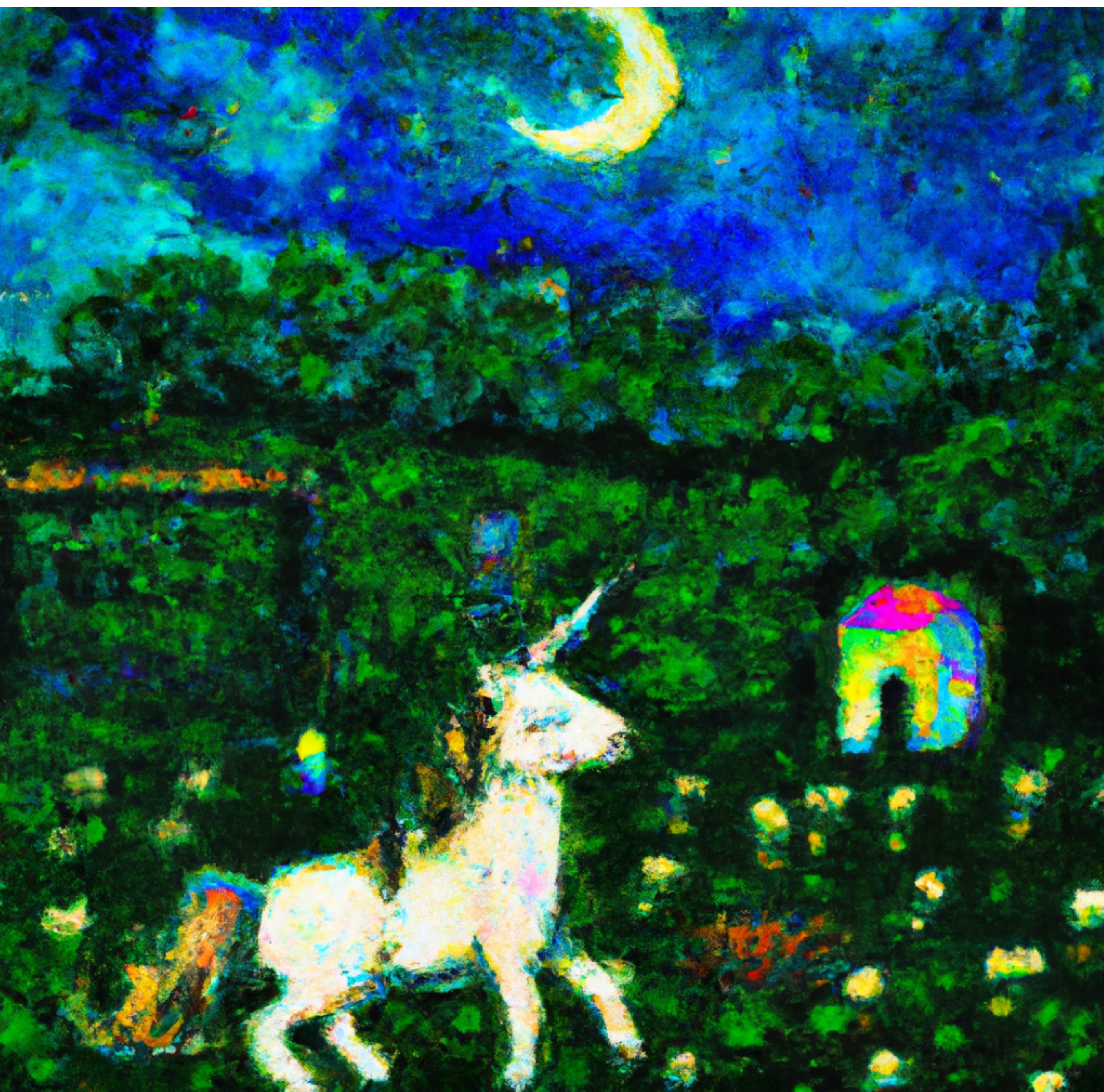


# Aurora's Adventure
